We are FC St Helens.

Formed in 2014 at the heart of the town, we are a club developing constantly and growing based on a strong held set of values. The 2014/15 campaign saw the club compete in the Carlsberg West Cheshire League, with a move to the Hallmark Cheshire Football League for the 2015/16 season. After successful years in the Cheshire Premier League being a consistent contender each year, FC secured the 2021/22 league title and the 2021 Lancashire FA Shield Trophy.

We now move into our long term goal of North West Counties Football, hoping to have a long sustainable future within the league.

2. Our Home



Windleshaw Sports has been around for over 100 years! It was very much part of the community as a cricket club since the late 1800s.

The demise of the cricket club in 2014 meant the football club could take over and start the process of the redevelopment of the area and we have been calling it our home since then. In 2017 the formal process of the **redevelopment plans began**, which included our **newly built 80 space parking facilities** down Windleshaw Road cleaning out an old fly tipping site and in turn helping cleaning up the local area. Plans are afoot to install **new floodlighting** and **year on year investment** into the **playing surface**.

The clubhouse can host events of all types with a **capacity of 100**, the perfect venue for **mid range attendances**. We have recently **held multiple business breakfasts** for the local community to network and form strong relationships that benefit the surrounding area. We have found this to be extremely well received and plan to continue with more in the future.




